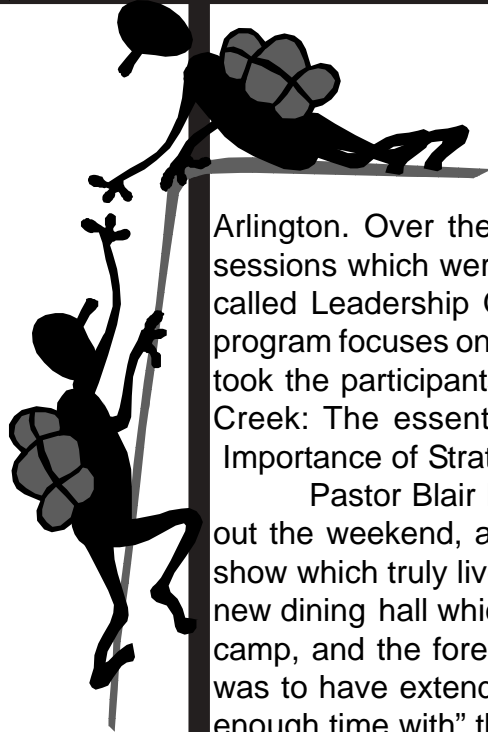

VISIONCAST: ONE HAND UP, ONE HAND DOWN

VisionCast is Allen Creek's annual retreat for those who want to take an active role in advancing the mission of the church in the coming year. In August, during the Pause, VisionCast took place at Camp Brotherhood - located in the "wilds" of Northeast Arlington. Over the course of three days, Allen Creekers participated in group sessions which were based on a brand new leadership training development tool called Leadership QUEST. Modeled after AC3's discipleship path, QUEST, this program focuses on taking the next step of discipleship: Leadership. Six presenters took the participants through the details of what it means to be a leader at Allen Creek: The essentials of Biblical Leadership, The Character of Leaders, The Importance of Strategy, Leadership Challenges, and more.

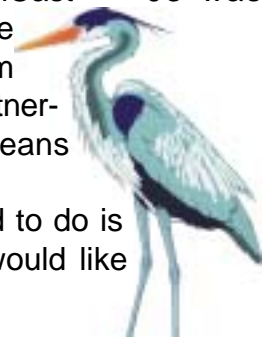

BUILDING A NEW BATCH OF LEADERS

The Elders, Board and Staff of Allen Creek have heard a clear and resounding call from God: "Grow up the next batch of leaders for my Church!" Too often leadership gets confused with "authority" or titles like "President" and "Manager". That's not the kind of leader God is talking about. God calls leaders to BE someone, not to DO something. Leadership at Allen Creek, or in any Biblically functioning Community is not based on what you know or who you know, but on a deep and abiding surrender to God's transforming power in the leader's life. It is out of a transformed life that leadership naturally flows.

IF **Leadership QUEST** sounds intriguing to you -VisionCast 03 was simply the beginning of Leadership QUEST. Allen Creek will be beginning a new comprehensive leadership training program comprised of four seminars, as well as numerous small group/partner-based gatherings, that will cover the full scope of what it means to be a leader in the church of Jesus Christ.

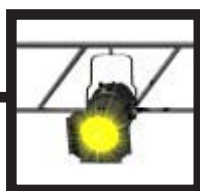
THE JOURNEY~ EXPLORATION

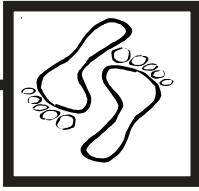
TEEN SCENE

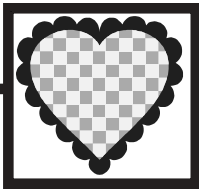
School Supplies are available for those who are needing them.

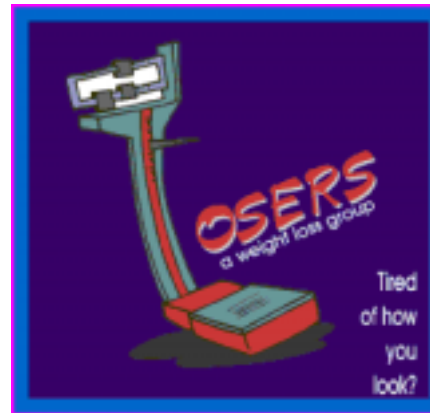
