At-a-Glance

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

(Positions with ♥ are a priority to fill in 08/09 – Sept. through July, August Off)

Greeters / Check-In Team ~ Help greet children and their families as they arrive at the Kreek Kids Check-In Center. Help register and check-in children, hand out KK newsletters, flyers and updates.

Time Commitment: 1-2 services per month.

Spiritual Gifts: Administration, Hospitality, Helps or Encouragement

♥ **TL – Transition Team Members** ~ TL's are the primary 'Go To' person or the Service Lead for the day to help troubleshoot any material and staffing needs during the ministry hour. When needed, they also switch and organize staff to different departments to insure healthy volunteer-to-child ratios. On Saturdays, they may also help with Check-In and serving food. TL's are willing to become a substitute helper on occasion.

Time Commitment: 1-2 services per month

Spiritual Gifts: Administration, Leadership, Encouragement, Helps

♥ **Nursery and Toddler Child Care Providers** ~ Help greet parents and sign in babies and toddlers as they arrive. Provide childcare in a safe and loving place for babies and toddlers. Implement basic sanitation and clean up procedures in the nursery or toddler rooms. Helpers are to be 14 years or older to work in the nursery with babies, 12 in the toddler room.

Time Commitment: 1-2 services per month.

♥ **Substitutes and Parent Partners** ~ Individuals who want to support Kreek Kids by being on a rotating sub list, have we got a place for you! Being available as a substitute just once or twice a month will help keep our classrooms well staffed, opened and S.A.F.E.



Time Commitment: Minimum of one service per month.

He or she should be fairly comfortable in an upfront role, energetic, and able to lead a medium sized group of children and helpers. **Saturday and Sunday openings.**



Time Commitment: ~ Rotation schedule: one month on, two months off.
1st service Option - Once or twice-a-month.

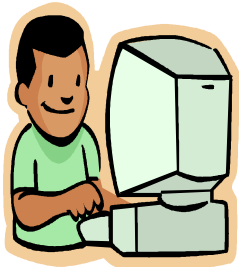
♥ **Preschool/Kindergarten Helpers**~ Help lead a simple Bible lesson and implement fun learning activities. Have fun as you provide a safe and loving learning environment for children. Help implement basic sanitation and clean up procedures. Helpers need to be 12 years or older to work in the Preschool Departments.

Time Commitment: 2 services per month. Or one month on, two months off.

Spiritual Gifts: Creative Communications, Mercy, Shepherding , Helps or Encouragement

♥ **1st Service Supervisors, Teachers and/or Helpers 1st-5th Grades** ~ Help and challenge school age students to learn more about the Bible using a variety of audio and visual tools. Class time can include free time, worksheets and computer Bible learning. Help with basic set up and room clean up.

Time Commitment: 1-2 services per month.

Drama or Music Team Leaders 3 years-5th Grades ~ Help develop a child's faith by organizing simple stage productions that use a variety of teaching tools; skits, puppet and musical activities. Scripts and puppets provided! Like music? Time Commitment: Saturday or Sunday, one or two services a month.

Resource and Cleaning Teams ~ Help organize lesson materials and crafts for our teaching teams; preschool and elementary. Many of these projects can be done at your home. If you think clean and bright play areas for kids are important, be part of a quarterly children's cleaning team.
